



State 2011-2012 Population Growth



- The Census Bureau produces population estimates each year as of July 1 using administrative data to estimate population change between census years and the decennial census count as a starting point.
- The U.S. population reached 313.9 million in 2012, a 0.75 percent increase since 2011.
- The majority of the fastest growing states are located in the West and the South.
- The West South Central area is the nation's fastest growing census region with a 1.34 percent growth rate, followed by the Mountain region, where the population grew 1.22 percent.
- Nevada was the sixth-fastest growth state in the nation in 2012. The population increased 1.43 percent. In 2012, Nevada's total population was 2,758,931 people, a gain of close to 40,000 relative to 2011.
