- The monthly job figures mentioned above are based on information from the Current Employment Statistics (CES) Program, which uses a sample of businesses to estimate current movements in the labor market.
- Through the first 11 months of this year, private sector job levels are trending 39,200 higher than a year ago.
- This is in addition to 11,500 new private sector jobs in 2011, 20,000 in 2012 and 29,200 in 2013.
- Should these trends hold through the end of the year, Nevada has the potential to add about 100,000 new jobs over the 2010-2014 period.
- A more accurate, but less timely, count of jobs is available using the Quarterly Census of Employment Wages (QCEW). Jobs gains measured by the QCEW through the first half of 2014 are consistent with that reported above.
