

BED Gross Job Gains vs. Gross Losses in Nevada

Business Employment Dynamics Nevada Private Sector Job Gains vs. Job Losses (Seasonally Adjusted)



- BED data enhances labor market perspective by delving beyond net employment changes into the sources of movement – job creation and destruction
- 2014:IIQ gross job gains at expanding or opening private sector establishments totaled 69,970. Over the same period, gross job losses at contracting or closing private sector establishments totaled 58,600.
- The difference between the number of gross job gains and the number of gross job losses equated to a “net” employment gain of 11,370 jobs in the private sector during the second quarter of 2014
- This represents the 15th consecutive quarter of net job growth, based upon BED measures.
