

Obstetricians/Gynecologists/Surgeons/Anesthesiologists Highest Paying Occupations in Nevada

(10 Occupations with Highest Annual Mean Wages; 2014 Occupational Employment Statistics Data)



- The Occupational Employment Statistics (OES) survey is a semi-annual mail survey measuring occupational employment and wage rates for wage and salary workers in nonfarm establishments in Nevada and all states.
- The highest paying occupations in Nevada are obstetricians/gynecologists, surgeons, and anesthesiologists, earning \$261,800, \$259,900, and \$257,300 per year on average, respectively.
- Of the highest paying occupations, the largest employment numbers belong to chief executives (1,500 jobs) and family/general practitioners (1,000 jobs).
- Eight of the ten highest paying occupations are generally employed in the health care industry. The only occupations that are not largely present in the health care industry are chief executives (which most commonly are employed in the corporate, subsidiary, and regional managing offices industry) and judges, magistrate judges, and magistrates (which, in Nevada, are employed only in the state and local government industries).
